Takht Bhai (Brother's throne) has been listed as UNESCO World Heritage Site, as it is an Indo-Parthian archaeological site of an ancient Buddhist monastery. This site is one of the most magnificent remains of Buddhism in the whole Gandhara, which have been exceptionally well-preserved. The site is located at 156 KM from Islamabad and 83KM from Peshawar, the main city of Khyber Pukhtunkhwa province.

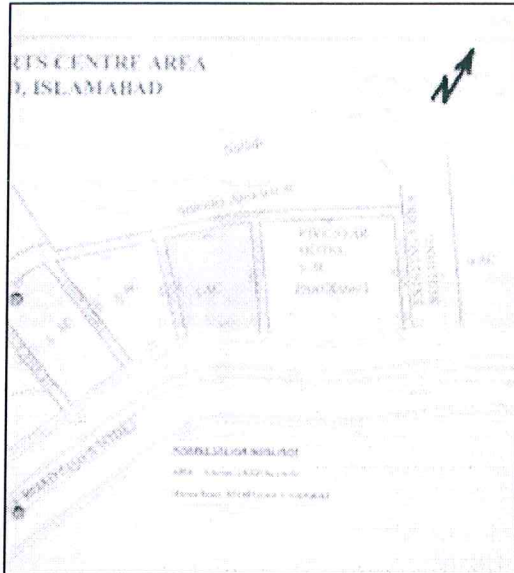

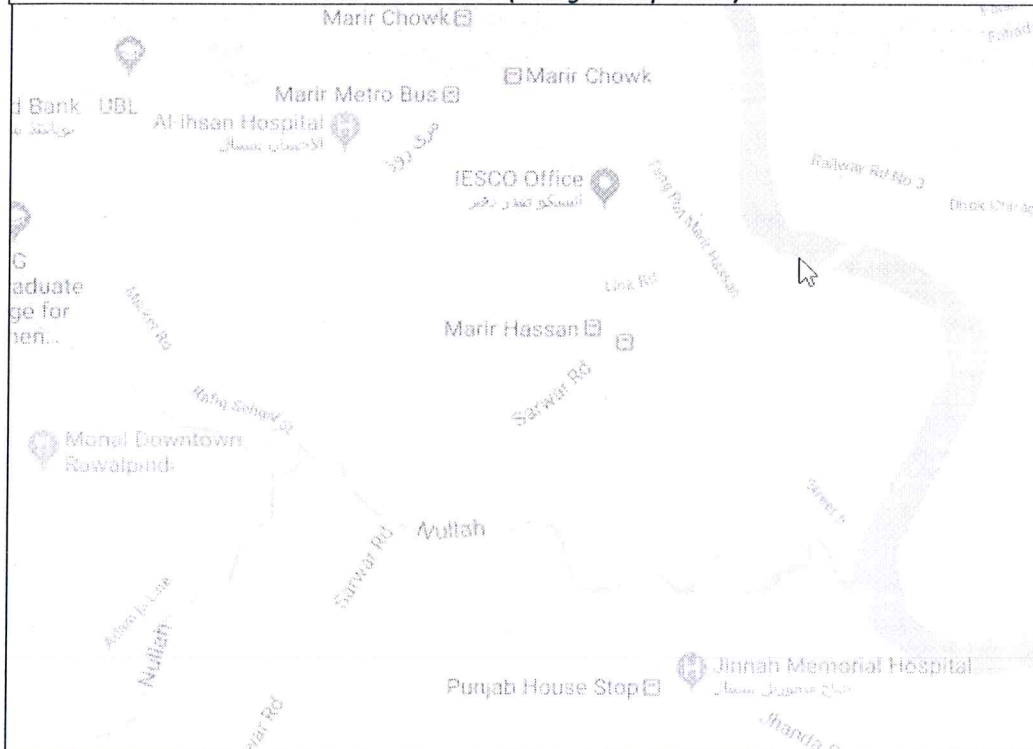


B-2: Plot 2 - Hotel Site

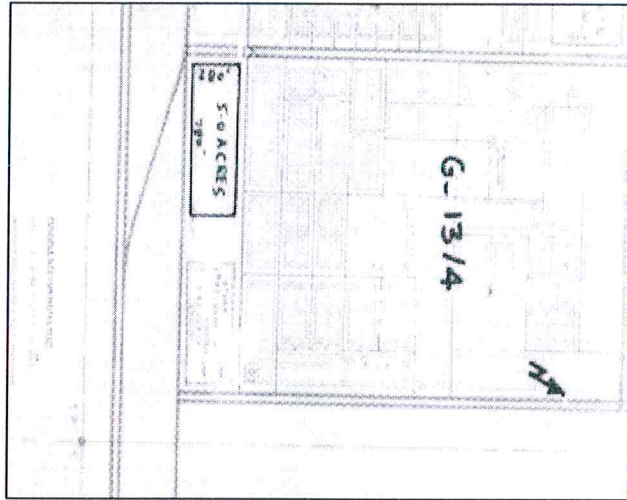


Murree Road (Google Map View)

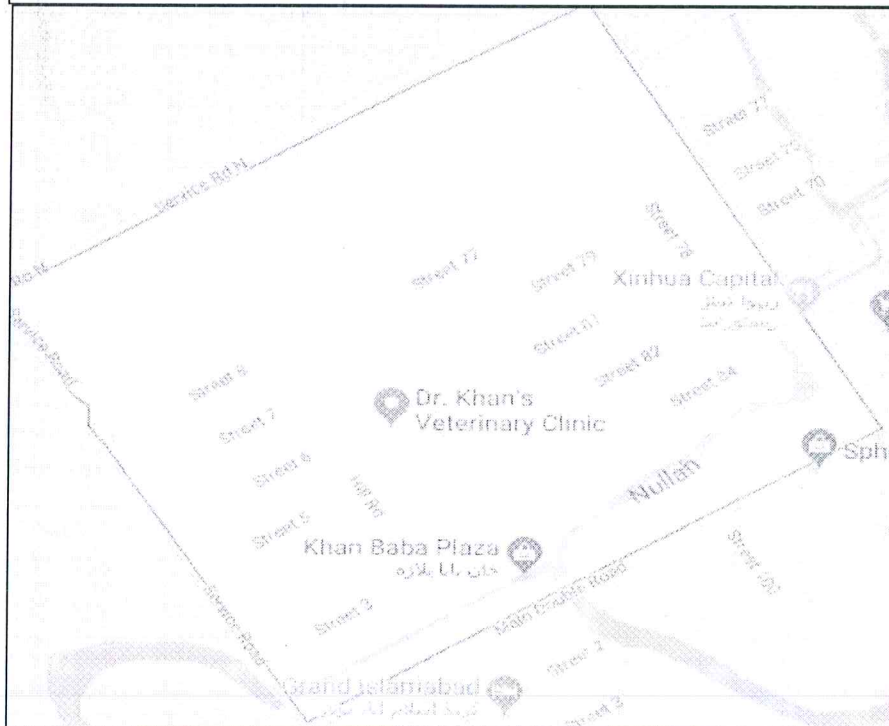




B-3: Plot 3 - Hotel Site

Northern Strip, E-11, Islamabad

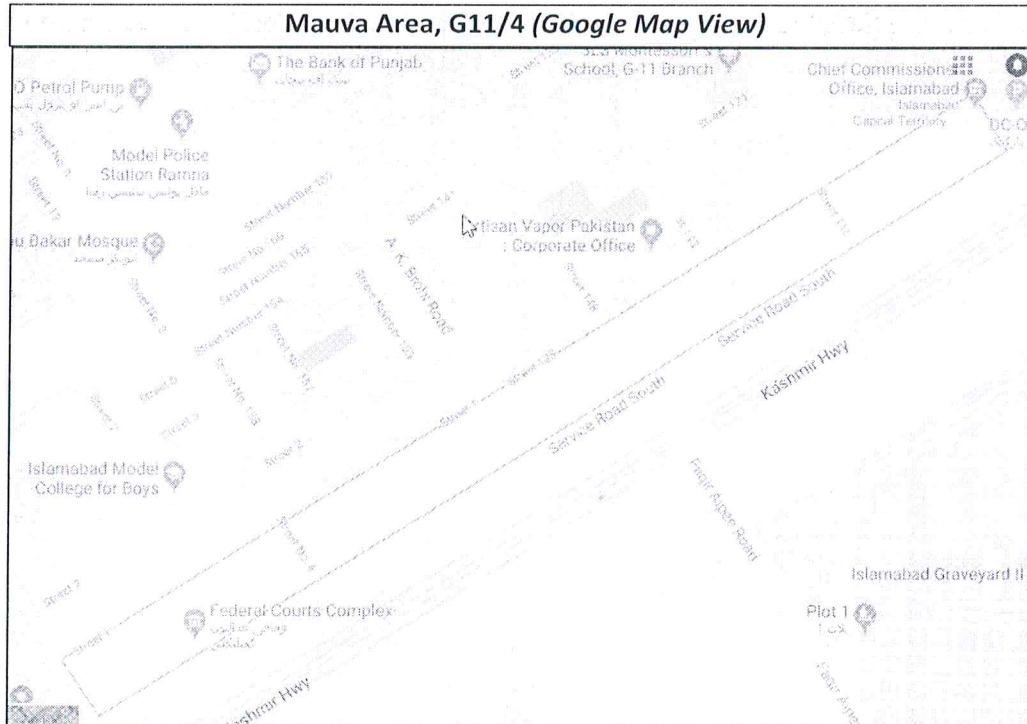
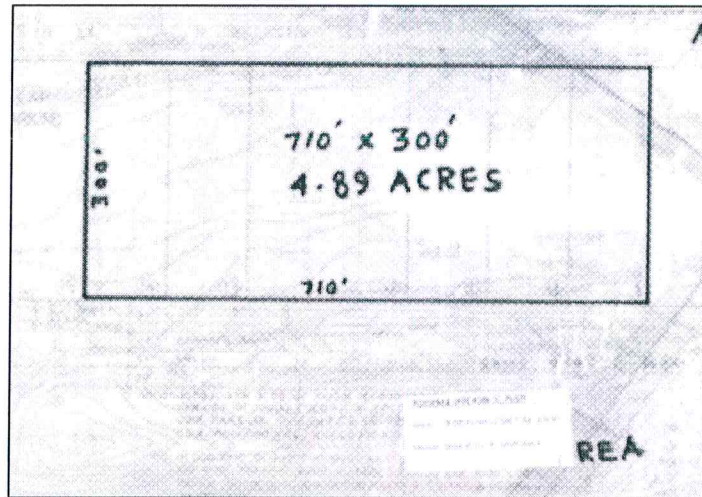


Northern Strip, E-11/3 (Google Map View)
